- Medical schools want to see that you stay busy






Why do a summer program?

- 2. Discovering new passions and interests
- 3. Strengthening expertise
- 4. Demonstrating commitment

Types of Summer Programs

• Clinical

- Shadowing, volunteer work, pre-health programming, etc.
- Research
- Service
 - education, health, policy etc.
- Internships
 - industry, academic, public health, etc.





Considerations for Choosing Summer Programs

- Program duration
 - Do these dates conflict with my class or exam schedules?
- Financial Compensation
 - Is there any stipend or pay?
 - Am I responsible for covering housing, travel, food, etc?
- Eligibility
 - School year? Citizen-status?
- Deadlines
 - When does the application open?
 - Do I need to ask for letters of recommendation? Send transcripts?
 - When is the last day I can submit?

Examples of Summer Programs: Research

The Leadership Alliance Summer Research Early Identification Program

- **Program duration:** 8–10 weeks
- Finances: covers stipend, and travel and housing expenses
- Application: Opens: November 1st // Closes: February 1st
- Program highlights:
 - Hosted at leading academic institutions across the country
 - Matched with a research mentor
 - Make oral or poster presentations at the Leadership Alliance National Symposium

Examples of Summer Programs: Internships

Columbia University's Summer Public Health Scholars Program

- **Duration:** 10 weeks
- Finances: stipend, housing, transist, and travel assistance provided
- Application: opens end of November// closes end of January
- Program highlights:
 - Public Health Coursework (e.g., introduction to public health, epidemiology, and health disparities and cultural competence)
 - Internship Placements and Mentorship
 - Field Trips (e.g., Center for Disease Control and Prevention, Mount Sinai Adolescent Health Center, Harlem Grown Inc., Project SAFE Brownsville Neighborhood Health Action Center)

Examples of Summer Programs: Service

Collective Power for Reproductive Justice

- **Duration:** 10 weeks
- Finances: stipend provided (housing, meals, and travel are not)
- Application: opens end of November// closes end of January
- Program highlights:
 - Partners with Host Sites across the country that tackle diverse aspects of reproductive health (e.g. housing, immigration, education)
 - A 3 day training at the annual CLPP conference will include workshops on non-profit organizations, grassroots organizing, communication, reproductive rights and health and social justice, and self-care
